

OPNA SPRING 2021 GENERAL MEETING

Minutes Monday 4/19 VIA ZOOM Live Video Conference

Meeting opened at 6:29pm by OPNA President Kirk Kilgore with Joanne Viola conducting.

Members & guests were welcomed. A total of 21 people were in attendance including:

 - CFW Community Engagement Office has a bulletin to share with faith-based communities that provides city information, such as COVID-related topics, with worship communities

 - Re-Districting Recommendations were approved by city council
 - To report any neighborhood-related issues to the City, one can now use the MyFW app, located on City of Fort Worth website or downloadable on your mobile device.
- Councilman Byrd discussed the City's hiring freeze and the use of \$185 million of Federal COVID funds to be used for assisting struggling families, small business owners and infrastructure improvements.
- Michael Crain spoke about being available as a resource to our neighborhood going forward.
- We were reminded that the water/sewer/repaving project on Ranch View Rd should be completed by March 2022.
- Minutes from our 2020 FALL General Meeting were approved with no revisions.
- Treasurer's Report was submitted by the OPNA Treasurer.
 - 2020 Membership Dues \$11,730
 - Overton Park Elementary School Contributions \$2,500
 - Median Improvements \$13,360
 - Median Maintenance \$5,723
 - Neighborhood Watch Expense \$1,158
 - Operations \$721
 - Insurance \$840
 - Median Water \$492
- The 2021 membership drive is under way.
- The OPNA is looking for a volunteer to be our Secretary.
- It was proposed that we consider establishing a separate fund to be donated to the Overton Park Elementary PTA, so ALL OPNA neighbors could have an opportunity to contribute yearly to our namesake neighborhood school. This can be voted on in our Fall general meeting.
- We were reminded that early voting starts today and the general election is May 1st. Voting can take place at the Southwest Regional Library.
