

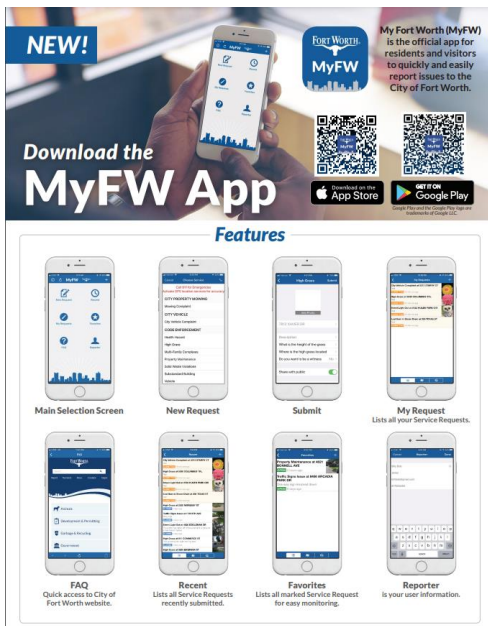
Meeting Minutes of the Overton Park Neighborhood Association (OPNA)

2023 SPRING GENERAL MEETING

Held on Monday April 24th at 6:30PM

At Overton Park Elementary School (OPE), 4865 Briarhaven Road, Fort Worth, TX 76109

- Meeting was opened at 6:30 by OPNA board member Mitch Reitman
- Members, visitors, and guests were welcomed. Visitors include Michael Crain, Connie Smith, Theresa Magana, CJ Evans, and Kevin Lynch.
- Treasury report was reviewed and approved.
- Minutes from the Fall 2022 General Meeting were reviewed and approved.
- Michael Crain introduces Lauren Prieur, new Director of Transportation Public Works.
 - Laura suggests members use the MyFW App to make reports and official complaints. Laura reports that issues like potholes can be addressed in 24-48 hours. If you can not use the app, call 817-392-1234.



- Work on University Drive is in progress. Electrical work is currently being done. 1 lane will be closed on either side as work is being completed. All lanes will be open for major city events like TCU football games.
- Work on Rogers Road in progress. Current plan is to complete May 22nd. Prior to Colonial Golf Tournament.
- Speed bumps are being removed as they are against city ordinance. Neighborhood Traffic Calming program is working to place speed tables in appropriate areas.
- Connie Smith, principal at Overton Park Elementary, announces she is retiring at the end of the school year. She also shares that the elementary school has approved to have a police officer on campus full time, and she encourages the community to continue supporting and funding initiatives at the school.
- Theresa Magana, Community Engagement Liaison for the City of Fort Worth, is introduced.
